Sub.- Conduct of 22nd Sub-Junior, Junior & Senior National Sqay Championship 2021-22 to be held at Navelim, Goa from 26th to 30th Dec, 2021.

Sir

I am directed to convey approval of the Competent Authority for the sanction of a grant not exceeding Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh only) to the Secretary General, Sqay Federation of India for conducting the above subject cited National Championships. This grant is of non-recurring by nature. The settlement of the bills will be done on reimbursement basis.

As per terms and conditions of this Ministry's letter No.12-5/2013-SP.III, GOI, MYAS, Department of Sports, (SP.III Section), Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi dated: 4th November, 2015, The Assistance indicated above shall be utilized for provision of Boarding & Lodging for this purpose, assistance up to Rs.1000/- per head per day for 'A' Class cities and up to Rs.500/- per head per day at other venues will be admissible. The RSF is expected to meet the expenses on other items from their own resources. These rates may be linked by MYAS/SAI to CPI.

2. The Grant is subject to the conditions mentioned below:-

- i) That at least 75% of the total affiliated units will take part in the Championship. In case percentage of participation is between 50 and 74.9 Government grant will be reduced by 25%. However, no grant will be payable for participation below 50%.
- ii) That the grantee shall execute a bond with two sureties to the President of India for acceptance of terms and conditions of the payment of Grant-in-aid before release the payment.
- iii) The grantee shall maintain subsidiary accounts of the grants-in-aid received from the Government.

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- iv) The grantee shall maintain a register of assets in the prescribed form GFR 12. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of government grant except those declared as obsolete & unserviceable or condemned as per the procedure laid down in the General Financial Rules shall not be disposed of without the prior approval of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- v) The account shall be audited by the International Auditors of grantee and finally by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under Section 14 of the CAG of India (Duties, Power and conditions of Service) Act, 1971.
- vi) The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the scheme or work concerned to another institution or organization and shall abide by the terms and conditions of the grant. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant, for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will be required to refund the entire amount with interest thereon @ 10% per annum. As per Rule 209(6) (ix).
- vii) The UC should also disclose whether the specified, quantified and qualitative target that should have been reached against the amount utilized. Were in fact reached, and if not, the reasons therefore as per Rule 212 (1).
- viii) The accounts of all grantee institutions or organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of department, whenever the institution or organization is called upon to do so and a provision to this effect should invariably be incorporated in all orders sanctioning grants-in-aid. As per Rule 211 (1).
- ix) The grantee shall submit the utilization certificate in prescribed form GFR 12 A received for the purpose duly signed by the General Secretary/President within 06 months after closure of financial year as per Rule 212 (1) of GFR.
- x) That the grant is adjustable on the basis of the actual expenditure. For this purpose, a statement indicating the list of participants (state-wise) and an audited statement of income and expenditure (duly audited by a Chartered Accountant) in the manner as mentioned in Para 2 above may be sent to this Ministry.
- xi) That a performance cum achievement report (2 copies) in respect of the event for which that grant has been sanctioned should be forwarded to this Ministry within 02 months of the event.
- xii) That no advertisement of tobacco and Liquor will be displayed during the event, the breach of which entails the cancellation of government grant.

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- xiii) That in case of Senior Championship, the Federation will have to conduct the Junior and Sub-Junior Championships in the same financial year. In case these are not conducted, the grant released for the Senior Championship will be recovered from the Federation.
- xiv) That it should be compulsory for the Federation to hold state level tournaments in all states for both Men and Women.
- xv) As far as district tournaments are concerned, it should be held in at least 50% district for Men & Women before the Federation becomes eligible for release of remaining grants and fresh assistance.
- xvi) The grant in aid is further subject to the conditions laid down in GFRs as amended from time to time.
- xvii) The amount of the grant will be debited to the head, under the provision of the Scheme of Financial Assistance to National Sports Federations (NSFs).
- xviii) The bills will be settled on reimbursement basis soon after receipt of Utilization Certificate in GFR 2017 Form- 12A with original bills/vouchers and other relevant documents within 15 days after completion of the event to the O/o Executive Director (TEAMS).
